## Agreement for Reciprocal Membership Privileges Between The Physical Society of Japan And The Physical Society of Taiwan

The Physical Society of Japan (hereafter, JPS) and The Physical Society of Taiwan (hereafter, TPS) mutually agree to enhance interactions among their members and to extend reciprocal membership privileges as outlined below.

- 1. Members of the JPS (TPS) may submit papers to the TPS (JPS) meetings with the same privileges and limitations as TPS (JPS) members;
- 2. Members of the JPS (TPS) may register at the TPS (JPS) meetings at member rates:
- 3. JPS and TPS agree to exchange journals, including TPS's Abstracts (Program and Abstracts of TPS meetings), Bimonthly Journal of Physics, and other physics journals managed by TPS such as the Chinese Journal of Physics (CJP), with JPS's Abstracts (Program and Abstracts of JPS meetings), Butsuri, and Journal of the Physical Society of Japan;
- 4. Both Societies agree to enhance the exchange of information on meetings, seminars, and workshops organized by either society;
- 5. Both societies agree to encourage bilateral visits by officers to facilitate direct exchanges of views and to strengthen the relationship between the societies.

This agreement shall automatically renew unless either JPS or TPS submits written notice of its intent not to renew prior to the expiration of the current term.
